Candidate Summary: My name is Joy Heinbaugh and I am running as a Republican Candidate for the Franklin County Register and Recorder. I was born and raised in Franklin County in the Waynesboro Area where I currently reside with my husband and three grown sons. A 1996 graduate of the Waynesboro Area Senior High School and a member of the National Honor Society.

While I don't consider myself a politician, I now have the opportunity to run for Register and Recorder. A office that I have worked in for the last 18 years. For those that don't know, the former Register and Recorder, Linda Miller, retired after 35 years of service. I was hired as a Department Clerk in December 2004 and then advanced to First Deputy in January 2016. As her First Deputy, she has endorsed me to run to fill her seat. I have been serving as Interim Register and Recorder since October 1st, 2022.

Some responsibilities of this elected position are as follows:

- Record all documents pertaining to land records including deeds, mortgages, easements, Right-of-Ways, satisfactions, plans, etc. (Approx. 19,000/year)
- Handles the probate of estates upon the death of a loved one and appointing proper executors or administrators (approx. 800/year)
- Collection agency for the Dept of Revenue for State Realty Transfer Tax and Inheritance Tax (for year ending 2022 over 30 million dollars was collected by our office)
- Recording of Military Discharge Records & Notary Bonds and Commissions
- Attend Court hearings as a witness to delinquent estate filings.
- Make daily bank deposits, prepare monthly state reports, reconcile several accounts and participate in various audits.

I love my job and ask the voters of Franklin County to "CHOOSE JOY" for Register and Recorder on the May 16, Municipal Primary ballot. While my name will appear on the Republican ballot, I ask my Democrat friends to write me in on their ballot (make sure to blacken the oval in front of my name)

If elected, I promise I will continue to provide decisive leadership, competence, and superb customer service to the residents of Franklin County while committing to work in a full-time capacity. I am fiscally conservative and as I will be a working Supervisor, I plan to eliminate one full time vacant staff position, thus saving the taxpayer's money.
