How to Vote in the 2023 Local Elections...

ELIGIBILITY

Before the next primary, special, municipal, or general election:

- Be a citizen of the United States for at least one month
- Be a resident of Pennsylvania and the election district in which you want to register and vote for at least 30 days
- Be at least 18 years of age on or before the day of the next election

Already registered to vote in another state?

You must contact the Board of Elections in the previous voting district & cancel your registration in that state before applying to PA.

Already registered to vote in PA?

Complete a change of address to vote in person at your new college address by Oct. 24th OR apply for vote by mail at your prior home address by Nov. 1st.

ADDRESS

- Register and vote where you live while attending college in PA or at your prior home address, provided your family or guardian still resides there.
- If you are registering where you live while attending college in PA, you can use either an on-campus or off-campus address.
- If you do not have a PA drivers license or state ID, you can submit your social security number as proof of identification.
- You can only be registered in one place at a time.
- Whatever you choose, you have to register to vote by Oct. 24th.

VOTER ID

When voting at a polling place for the first time, you must show proof of identification, either with photo or not. Acceptable forms of ID include: Student ID, U.S. passport, PA driver's license, PennDOT ID card, Commonwealth issued ID, U.S. Government issued ID, U.S. Armed Forces ID, Employee ID or your new recently issued voter registration card.
