1 in 5 eligible voters are not registered to vote

#### Voter turnout averaged 43%

from 2020-2023, meaning less than half of registered voters cast their ballot during an election



Ages 18-24 make up only 7% of registered voters

the smallest compared to other age groups, the largest of which is Ages 55-64 (17.6%)
